

Teacher Expectations	What does it look like
Students are prepared to learn	 Students bring all required books, equipment and uniform. Students enter the classroom in an orderly manner All learning materials are promptly removed from bags and placed on desks. Students communicate clearly, in advance, any issues which may impact learning.
Students engage in learning	 Students begin work promptly. Students ask for clarification immediately if required. Students work collaboratively to maximise learning. Students maintain a neat and accurate record of work completed.
Students follow teacher directions	Students follow directions immediately upon instruction without argument or question.
Students demonstrate respect	 Students use appropriate language at all times. Students care for property belonging to themselves, the school and their peers. Students ensure others right to learning is upheld. Students keep work areas/playground clean and tidy at all times. Students display socially acceptable behaviour at all times.
Students are safe at all times	 Students remain seated unless otherwise given permission. Students are mindful of others personal space. Students tone and level of voice is environment appropriate. Students ensure they are in supervised areas at all times. Students take ownership and responsibility for their behaviour when travelling to and from school. Students use appropriate staff to assist in resolving conflict or disputes.

Head Teacher Expectations	What does it look like

Students take responsibility for their behaviour/learning.	 Students cooperate with teachers to ensure a conducive learning environment is present across the school. Students accept teacher consequences for behaviour and understand they are part of the learning process. Students make every effort to resolve matters in a positive and timely manner with teachers so they access the full curriculum.
Students respect the right of teachers to teach and students to learn	 Students display a positive approach to learning and complete all content/lesson activities set by classroom teachers. Students treat teachers and their peers with dignity and respect.
Students take opportunity to resolve issues with their class room teacher	 Students complete faculty support card and ensure parents are shown upon completion. Students attend reflection to reflect and learn from previous experience.

Students successfully resolve poor behaviour	 Students complete HT support card and ensure parents are signing and informed of progress. Students complete faculty/whole school reflection to reflect and as part of the learning process. Students access recommended support services such as Student Advisors and School Counsellors.
