About the Year 7 Scholarship Program

At Goulburn High School, we encourage and support all students to aspire, achieve and succeed. One way we will do this for our Year 7 2026 cohort is to make available a range of scholarships for students who show passion and dedication in aspects of the curriculum, leadership and extra-curricular activities.

Students may apply for more than one scholarship, and recipients will be advised during the finalisation of the enrolment process. One to two scholarship will be awarded in each category as specified over the page.

Each scholarship includes throughout Year 7 only:

- Payment of all Year 7 School Fees
- Year 7 Book Pack
- Scientific Calculator
- Uniform vouchers to the value of \$100.00
- Year 7 Camp
- Scholarship Recognition Certificate

Scholarship Categories

Student Leadership - 2 Scholarships. Available to students who have been part of their school leadership team, this scholarship recognises the important role students play as leaders in high school. We aim to foster leadership skills and encourage students to play an active role in school decision-making. The recipients of this scholarship will also become Year 7 member of the Student Representative Council.

Academic Excellence - 2 Scholarships. This scholarship recognises a student who has shown dedication to their studies and is coming to high school highly motivated to continue their learning journey. The recipients will demonstrate an outstanding record of academic achievement in primary school across multiple curriculum areas. In addition to the scholarship, the recipients will be offered a place in our prestigious High Potential Class.

Agriculture - 1 Scholarship. Many students from our partner Primary Schools have had the opportunity to visit our farm and participate in Agriculture lessons. The recipient of this scholarship will show a strong interest in Agriculture and learning more about this area of the curriculum. In addition to the scholarship, the recipient will be offered a place in our Agriculture High Aspirations Program.

Drama / Dance - 1 Scholarship. This scholarship recognises a student's talents in Drama and/or Dance. The recipient will have a strong background in dance or drama and a passion for extending their experiences in this area in high school. In addition to the scholarship, the recipient will be offered a place in our Drama and Dance High Aspirations Program.

Visual Arts - 1 Scholarship. This scholarship recognises the talents of a student in Visual Arts. The recipient will have a strong background in creative arts, and a passion for extending their experiences in this area in high school. In addition to the scholarship the recipient will be offered a place in our Visual Arts High Aspirations Program.

Music Performance - 1 Scholarship. Our school is renowned for its talented musicians and vocalists who are nurtured by our passionate Music teachers. This scholarship is designed to recognise a musician and/or vocalist with a background in this area they would like to pursue in high school. In addition to the scholarship, the recipient will be offered a place in our Music Performance High Aspirations Program.

Sporting Excellence - 1 Scholarship. Valuing excellence in both sport and sportsmanship, the recipient of this scholarship will demonstrate a high level of achievement in their chosen sport/s. They will also demonstrate the values of good sportsmanship in their application. In addition to the scholarship the recipient will be offered a place in our All Codes High Aspirations Program.

STEM - 1 Scholarship. The combined disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics assist in developing highly valuable skills in design, creativity and problem solving. The recipient of this scholarship will demonstrate a strong interest in STEM education. In addition to the scholarship the recipient will be offered a place in our STEM High Aspirations Program.

Eligibility

Only students enrolled at Goulburn High School for Year 7, 2026, are eligible to apply. Scholarship applications from out of area students will be considered only if their out of area enrolment is successful. Applications from students who have not enrolled in Goulburn High School for Year 7, 2025, will not be considered.

Application Forms

Application forms will be distributed to Year 6 students within the Goulburn Community of Schools from Monday 24 February 2025, along with the High Potential Class Application pack. Students from other schools enrolling at Goulburn High School must contact the school office to have an application form forwarded to them directly. Application forms will be available from Monday 24 February 2025.

Submissions

Scholarship applications must be submitted by **Friday 4 April 2025** either in hard copy to our school office or via email to goulburn-h.school@det.nsw.edu.au. All Scholarship applications will be considered by the Scholarship Panel consisting of the Principal, Year 7 Deputy Principal, Year 7 Advisor and the Transition Advisor. The decisions of the Scholarship Panel are final, and no appeals will be accepted.

Offers

Notifications of the shortlisting of student scholarship applications will be finalised by Friday 2 May 2025. Shortlisted applicants will be required to submit a portfolio of work to support their application. The portfolio is due on Friday 29 August 2025.
