Student Leadership - 2 Scholarships:

Available to students who have been part of their school leadership team, this scholarship recognises the important role students play as leaders in high school. We aim to foster leadership skills and encourage students to play an active role in school decision-making. The recipients of this scholarship will also become a Year 7 member of the Student Representative Council.

Academic Excellence - 2 Scholarships

This scholarship recognises a student who has shown dedication to their studies and is coming to high school highly motivated to continue their learning journey. The recipients will demonstrate an outstanding record of academic achievement in primary school across multiple areas of the curriculum. In addition to the scholarship the recipients will be offered a place in our prestigious High Potential Class.

Agriculture - 1 Scholarship

Many students from our partner Primary Schools have had the opportunity to visit our Farm and participate in Agriculture lessons. The recipient of this scholarship will show a strong interest in Agriculture and learning more about this area of the curriculum.
